Also, the children learn to feed themselves while sitting in a chair at the table. Having the children work on their pincher grasp is a huge concept while in the Mobile Infant Community, they learn how to use their index finger and flat part of their thumb and this helps them develop the muscles to later hold a pencil. We strive to meet the child’s individual needs and allow them to grow developmentally before moving to the next stage. This room is constantly on the go and busy, busy, busy.
